Eligibility

Current postgraduate students and final / third-year undergraduate students in specific partner institutes.

Research Length

60 to 180 days (about two to six months)
(The program must end before/on 20th December)

Financial Support

Maximum to NTD 27,500 (tax included) per month for admitted students(Up to two-month subsidization)

Application Process

All applicants must firstly identify and contact a full-time professor at NYCU to be their research supervisor. Please email the application documents in one file before the deadline of each round to the NYCU coordinator.

- Application form (typewritten) (doc.)(odt.)
- Curriculum vitae (CV) in English
- Research proposal (no more than one page)
- Official transcript of academic records in English or Chinese
- Invitation letter from NYCU supervisor
 (It should be formal with the professor's signature, department, and contact information)

- Latest enrollment letter from the home institution (Please make sure the time covers your duration of stay in NYCU)
- A copy of the Passport (valid for at least three months)
- A statement issued by the home university indicates internship or research is a graduation criterion or a part of the course requirement. (This is a compulsory visa application requirement only for undergraduate applicants)

Notice

Applicants are not allowed to change the research period once admitted to the program; please confirm the research duration with the supervisor before the application.

The result would be announced three weeks after each deadline, please check the email regularly for the admission notice.

Division of Overseas Student Affairs will email the "Welcome Package" to admitted students in which registration, arrival information, and dormitory application are contained.

During the research period, expenses such as accommodation, facilities, and other necessary fees are at student's own cost and should be paid upon their arrival.
