Zusammenfassende Bewertung der aktuellen Q+Ampel-Klausur durch die Senatsbeauftragten für Qualitätsentwicklung

“The delegates of the Heidelberg University Senate were impressed by the effort put into the Santiago-Heidelberg cooperation, especially since the program is a cooperation between three universities, not only two. The degree program is well established, attracts students from all over Latin America and is attractive to professionals from various disciplines. Governance of risk and resources is at the center of social and political issues in Latin America. Students said that they were very content with study advisory services at HCLA (Heidelberg Center for Latin America) both in the application procedure as well as in the course of their studies. Support provided by lecturers is also held in high esteem. The group size of 20-25 students per year was named as an additional plus, and due to cooperation with two top universities of Santiago there is a wide array of choice regarding the curriculum. The delegates were impressed by a large variety of teaching and examination methods used by the lecturers, and all partners reported that teaching evaluations take place on a regular basis. Methods of interactive learning are especially attractive. The degree program survey as well as talks with the students showed that the program is running smoothly. Notwithstanding the many strengths of the program the delegates would like to comment on some aspects: The admission requirements need to be revised to comply with current Baden Württemberg State Law regulation. This should be done in a way that students with a (European or other) 3-year-Bachelor’s degree can also apply. The module handbook needs to be revised and infrastructure at the HCLA, especially wireless LAN access, could be improved.”
