Study requirements

German language proficiency: DSH-2 (= C1)
sufficent for most study programs, but also many exceptions:

Study requirements

Is my school leaving certificate from my home country comparable to the German Abitur?

Yes: direct application to the study program possible:

No: application for Studienkolleg possible (see next page)

Important note: The total duration of the study preparation (German language course and Studienkolleg (= preparatory course) must not exceed four semesters in total – requirement of the Foreigners' Registration Office –relevant for anyone who needs a residence permit



Application for preparatory course **Studienkolleg**

When a foreign school-leaving certificate is considered as only partly comparable with the German university entrance qualification you can apply for Studienkolleg: https://www.uni-heidelberg.de/en/study/application-enrolment/requirements-for-enrolment/studienkolleg-and-feststellungsprufung

Application deadline: 1 May – 30 June for the winter term

1 November – 15 December for the summer term

Required language level: B2 elevated level

Health insurance Krankenversicherung

Health insurance is mandatory for everyone in Germany

Statutory health insurance

e.g. AOK, TK, Barmer Krankenkasse, DAK, IKK, KKH...

Private health insurances

e.g. Mawista, Allianz, Care Concept, Educare24, DR-Walter Versicherung, ...



Health insurance for students in the German language courses

This group is not eligible for statutory student health insurance – **private health insurance required**

Change to statutory health insurance required upon start of a study programme!

Residence registration / Wohnsitzanmeldung



Residence registration ≠ Residence permit Wohnsitzanmeldung ≠ Aufenthaltserlaubnis

Where? Bürgeramt/Einwohnermeldeamt (Rathaus)

At the local city/town hall

Who?

Residence registration is mandatory for everyone!

When?

Within two weeks of you moving (in)

Required documents:

- Passport
- Wohnungsgeberbestätigung = Form signed by your landlord/landlady

Visa / Residence permit



(Entry) visa ≠ residence permit! (Einreise-) Visum ≠ Aufenthaltserlaubnis

Only non-EU/EEA nationals need a residence permit for Germany

→ EU/EEA nationals only need a valid identification card or passport



Residence permit for study purposes

on



Aufenthaltserlaubnis zu Studienzwecken

Students from outside the EU/EEA usually need:

Passport + visa or

Passport + residence permit + supplementary sheet (=Zusatzblatt)





or







Residence permit for study purposes *Aufenthaltserlaubnis zu Studienzwecken*



You must apply in due time and form!

When?

- Students who entered with an entry visa from the German embassy: eight weeks before the visa expires
- Students who entered without a visa: within three months of entry

Where?

Foreigners' Registration Office depending on your place of residence

= Ausländerbehörde

Residence permit for study purposes Aufenthaltserlaubnis zu Studienzwecken



Required documents

- Application form (online)
- Letter of admission <u>or</u> certificate of enrolment
- Current health insurance certificate
- Biometric passport photograph
- Passport with visa / entry stamp
- Proof of funding (€992 per month)
- Residence registration
- Fee: €100

Application or extension for residence permit at the Foreigners Registration Office is **only possible after registration of residence.**

Students in the German language courses

- Step 1: You will receive an e-mail from the student administraton on registration and enrolment in the student database heiCO:
 https://heico.uni-heidelberg.de please do not register before!
- Step 2: Upload documents:

Signed application for enrolment (online)

Passport photograph

Copy of your ID card

Copy of your higher education entrance qualification

Letter of acceptance from Max-Weber Haus

• Step 3: After your documents have been reviewed, you must accept the study place. You will receive information about this in heiCO and by email.



Enrolment at Heidelberg University Immatrikulation an der Universität Heidelberg

- Enrolment deadline: Friday, 31 October 2025 mandatory for everyone!
- Enrolment online only do not send any documents by mail.
- Pay semester fee of 161,10 € mandatory for eyeryone!

- Collect student ID card: After having uploaded the documents you'll receive a notification in heiCO and by e-mail.
