



INFORMATION ON THE PROCESSING OF PERSONAL DATA IN CONNECTION WITH THE ALUMNI E-MAIL-ADDRESS “HAIMAIL”

As required by art. 13 of the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR), we are informing you about the processing of your personal data by Heidelberg University in the context of the provision of an alumni e-mail address “HAI mail” for members of the HAI network.

You can apply for a personal HAI mail either when you register with the HAI network or at any later point during an existing HAI membership. A HAI mail is free of charge and follows the format firstname.lastname@alumni.uni-heidelberg.de. In individual cases, other designations can be made in consultation with the user.

The use of HAI mail is only possible together with a HAI membership. After the end of membership or termination of HAI mail, all personal, content and usage data as well as addresses and associated mailboxes will be irrevocably deleted.

 - Rectification of your data (art. 16 GDPR)
 - Erasure of your data (art. 17 GDPR, § 10 State Data Protection Act) unless the university is legally obliged to store the data
 - Right to data portability (art. 20 GDPR)
 - Right to lodge a complaint with the responsible supervisory authority for data protection (Commissioner for Data Protection and Freedom of Information for the State of Baden-Württemberg)
