

## Scholarship call: Regional Development Politics Programme REK\*

Within the "Baden-Württemberg Scholarship for students" programme for the promotion of international exchange, the Baden-Württemberg Foundation is awarding scholarships for the academic year 2025/26 to qualified students and graduates from **ACP countries**, **Least Developed Countries** and other traditionally underrepresented countries who would like to undertake study or research in Baden-Württemberg\*\*. To a lesser extent, Heidelberg students participating in an exchange in these countries may also be funded. A cooperation agreement with the exchange university is not strictly necessary. However, a formal recognition of cooperation would be welcomed.

**Scholarship amount:** minimum of  $600 \in$  a month for students and PhD students. In justified cases the scholarship may be increased.

The scholarship may not be combined with other scholarships intended for the support of a stay abroad (e.g. DAAD)

Duration of support:At least two and no more than eleven months.Subjects:All.

Applications can be handed in by Heidelberg reserchers who organise exchange activities for the academic year 2025/26 and already know of candidates for this exchange. Please let us know by **31 March 2025 at the latest.** 

Nominated candidates must later upload the following documents to the Baden-Württemberg Foundation online portal:

Letter of motivation with details of previous study

- CV
- Proof of grades, for example degree certificate or interim study report.
