For Heidelberg students and graduates*

In order to promote international exchange, the Baden-Württemberg Foundation is awarding scholarships for stays abroad in the academic year 2026/27 to highly qualified students and graduates. As the Baden-Württemberg Foundation has specified that the exchanges must be on a reciprocal basis, this announcement is primarily intended for participants of exchange programmes (except those under the ERASMUS scheme).

Scholarship amount: 800 € a month

The scholarship may not be combined with other scholarships intended for the support of a stay abroad (e.g. DAAD). The Baden-Württemberg scholarship counts as income and will lead to a deduction of 300 € a month from the Bafög.

Duration of support: At least three and no more than ten months. Plus, if applicable, one month for a language course.

Application deadline: 31 March 2026

Please upload the following documents:

- Narrative CV
- Letter of motivation
- Proof of matriculation/Acceptance as PhD candidate
- Transcript of records
- Certificates (including Abitur)
- Language certificate
- Reference from a professor
- Confirmation of nomination for the exchange and, if applicable, proof of exemption from tuition fees

Note: Participants in a bilateral exchange program only need to upload the application form, the letter of motivation and a current verified ToR, as the remaining documents are already available in the database.
