# CALL FOR APPLICATIONS HELLA BÜHLER PRIZE 2025

### What is the Hella Bühler Prize?

The Hella Bühler Prize - which comes with a prize money of **100,000 euros** - is granted by Heidelberg University and is one of the most valuable awards in the field of cancer research. It goes back to the dentist Dr Hella Bühler who bequeathed her fortune to the University with the stipulation that a prize in cancer research should be awarded from the proceeds.

# Who can apply?

Young researchers from Heidelberg University and its cooperation partners who have already attracted attention by the outstanding scientific quality of their work, but have not yet been appointed to a permanent professorship, can apply with a clinincal or non-clinical project in the field of cancer research. The Prize money can be used freely within the project.

# What application documents are required?

Please submit the following documents (in English):

- CV that clearly lists the group leader or independant status and includes a list of competitive funds acquired
- Project outline incl. project title (max. 3 pages) which illustrates how the award funds will be used
- Brief description of your scientific achievements
- List of significant publications
- Only required for young researchers of a cooperation unit: confirmation by the head of the cooperation unit that the research project is based at Heidelberg University to at least 50%

### How is the prize winner selected?

Applications will be reviewed and evaluated by an expert jury from the Field of Focus I, led by the Field of Focus I spokesperson, Prof. Dr Jan Lohmann.
