2020 funds: The minimum duration of your physical stay for study purposes is three months (90 days). Blended mobilities (i. e. the combination of physical presence for study purposes and virtual phases from Germany) are probably only possible under COVID-19 force majeure regulations.

2021 funds: The minimum duration of your physical stay for study purposes is two months (60 days). In general, blended mobilities are possible.
