Inhalt	<p>Academic Writing is a central component of all academic work and a necessary research skill both within a university environment and in the outside world. In a reader-centric culture such as ours, students and academic writers need to ensure that their papers, essays, publications, reports, and grant applications are logically sound, coherent, and formulated clearly and unambiguously if they want them to be successful. Thus, writing can be a productive and even rewarding task, but it can also present certain challenges, especially for less experienced writers. This blended learning course in English is meant for all advanced students wrapping up collected material or data for their term papers or theses. The workshop will guide participants through the complex process of academic writing and introduce them to practical tools and methods for improving their own writing process. In addition to completing the self-study units, regular meetings and structured feedback from peers, all students will also be able to receive individualized feedback on a piece of their writing during a voluntary writing consultation with the course instructor. Thus, participants will learn to apply the basic principles of effective academic writing to their own dissertation, proposal, or prospective publication. At the end of the workshop, they will leave the course with their own draft of a scientific text.</p>
