

CURRICULUM VITAE

Anne Sophie Luong was born in Bad Homburg in 2004 and began playing the violin at the age of six. After a year she was already studying with Prof. Yvonne Smeulers at the Frankfurt Conservatory and then with Prof. Susanne Stoodt at the HfMDK Frankfurt. She was also an academic at the International Music Academy in Berlin. Anne Sophie is currently a student with the Italian soloist Prof. Marco Rizzi at the Mannheim University of Music.

Anne Sophie won numerous prizes and awards. These include first prize in the international music competition "London Classical Music Competition 2022" and second prize in the "International Josef Mucka Violin Competition 2020" in Prague. She is also a multiple first federal prize winner at "Jugend musiziert" in the categories "Violin Solo" and "Duo: Piano and Strings" and has been awarded special prizes by the German Stiftung Musikleben and Sparkasse Bremen. The young violinist has appeared as a soloist with numerous orchestras, including the Sinfonietta Cologne, the Main Chamber Orchestra, the Frankfurter Berg Accordion Orchestra and the Frankfurt-Heddernheim Accordion Orchestra, and played in the Konzerthaus Berlin, the Deutsche Oper Berlin and the Schlosskirche Bad Homburg, among others.

Anne Sophie was an active participant in master classes by Vadim Gluzman, Christoph Poppen and Erik Schumann. She is also active in chamber music with her own piano trio and took part in the Kronberg Academy's chamber music project "With Music – Together". Anne Sophie performed at concerts at the Livorno Music Festival and Garda Lake Festival and gained concert experience with renowned musicians such as Evgeny Sinaiski, Ricardo Álvarez, Danilo Rossi and Alessandro Deljavan.

The young talent is a mentor scholarship holder of the Bad Homburg Castle Concerts Foundation. Anne Sophie currently plays a contemporary violin by Luca Salvadori, which was generously given to her by the Hermann and Dr. Irmgard Neumann Foundation.
