



Orientation for newly-admitted international students

Heidelberg University offers a wide range of information and orientation sessions for its newly-admitted students, to prepare them in the best way possible for their first semester in Heidelberg. Different information presentations, courses, workshops, guided tours and Q&A sessions are designed to cover the most important aspects of (student) life in Heidelberg.

Most of the sessions take place before lecture period starts, some sessions are held in the first week of lectures.
