



As part of the selection process for a **place of study in the programmes**

- **Medicine**
- **Dentistry**
- **Pharmacy**
- **Psychology (Bachelor)**

it is required that **non EU-/EWR-citizens with a foreign higher education qualification provide a proof of German language skills** in one of the following forms **at the time of application**:

- Proof of a passed German language test for the admission to universities (DSH-exam) of the highest level of performance (DSH-3), from a German university
- Proof of the Testprüfung Deutsch als Fremdsprache (TestDaF) with at least 2 partial exams on the level TDN 4 and 2 partial exams on the level TDN 5.
- Proof of the Goethe-certificate C 2: Großes Deutsches Sprachdiplom from the Goethe-Institut (from 01.01.2012), provided that at least 82 points were achieved in two of the four partial exams.
- Proof of the German language diploma from the Kultusministerkonferenz with at least 4 partial exams on the level C 1
- Proof of a written final exam in the subject German with a mark of at least 2,0 in a foreign school-leaving certificate which - in accordance with bilateral agreements - is recognised as sufficient proof of language proficiency for admission to higher education (see overview of accepted certificates in the attachment of the current valid framework of the Kultusministerkonferenz (KMK) "Zugang von ausländischen Studienbewerbern mit ausländischem Bildungsnachweis zum Studium an deutschen Hochschulen: Nachweis von Sprachkenntnissen")
- Proof of a written final exam in the subject German in the exam to determine the suitability of foreign applicants to study at universities in Germany ("Feststellungsprüfung") with a mark of at least 2,5.
