In order to find out which course at the Studienkolleg (G, M, S, T, W) is required to study a specific subject, the following is a list of all the study courses leading to a Bachelor of Arts, Bachelor of Science, or State-certified examination currently offered at Heidelberg University. Study course - Studienkolleg course

In order to qualify for the respective specialized study course, the assessment test (so-called *Feststellungsprüfung*) must be passed in the Studienkolleg course / one of the Studienkolleg courses stated in the column next to it.

Ratio in percent: 100%, 75%, 50%, 25%

The **respective ratio** given refers to the extent to which a specialized subject can be studied. In a bachelor's programme students may earn 100 % of their credits on one subject or distribute the credits across two subjects at a ratio of 75%/25% or 50%/50%. Some subjects can only be studied as a second one. They are marked as 50% (X2).

Option to become a teacher (*Lehramtsoption*)

The teacher training at Heidelberg University is done via the bachelor's degree so-called Lehramtsoption ("teaching option"). This is a prerequisite for the Master of Education and the access to professional teaching.
